Congratulations on taking the first step on a journey filled with fun, adventure, and personal development! We welcome all boys and girls to join us in one of the greatest experiences a child can have.

#### **Cub Scout**

Boys and girls in K-5th grade interested in fun and challenging activities that promote character development and physical fitness.

#### **Dens**

A small group of Cub Scouts who are the same gender and in the same grade. Boys and girls dens may coordinate activities together but are technically separate.

#### **Pack**

A pack is made up of all the dens. Larger events such as award ceremonies, camping, hikes, and field trips are often done as a pack.













### **Pack 207 Logistics**

**Pack Meetings - 1X per month:** all members of the pack meet as one to celebrate accomplishments, participate in activities, and build relationships. Includes award ceremony, games, and songs.

Pack meetings are the 1st Tuesday of each month starting 6:30PM at 1504 Minnesota Ave, San Jose.

**Den Meetings - 1X or 2X per month:** small meetings where den members (same grade) meet to pursue adventures which fulfill requirements for rank advancements. Parents of each den provide input on an optimal time and location for their den's meeting.

**Pack Outings & Events - 1X+ per month:** optional events giving scouts a change of scenery. Examples include volunteering, overnight camping, hikes, fire station visits, and the *pinewood derby*!

**Annual Dues - 1X per year:** \$290 = \$165 pack dues + \$125 council registration fees
Pack dues cover each scout's annual registration fee and operational fees. Included in each scout's fees are
a pinewood derby car, rank awards, adventure awards, pack 207 t-shirt, and rank related items such as the
handbook, hat, neckerchief, and slide. New scouts also have a one time registration fee with the council.
