



- All notes are made using your embouchure (lips) and changing the airflow (faster or slower) using your diaphragm and tongue - it's kind of like whistling!
- It's super fun


This includes: pinewood derby car, pack t-shirt, ranks & awards



Some of these we will coordinate as a pack, but families are always encouraged to go on their own as well.


